A Refreshing in Jesus the Lord

Acts 2:36 "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah."

Fundamental Truths of God:

- Jesus Christ is King and Lord, placed and positioned and empowered by God. (Luke 2:11)
- Jesus Christ the Lord is the "Master" of all that God has given Him through the humility of service unto the Father and given Him the name above every other name. (Philippians 2:9-11, John 10:29, John 16:15)
- King Jesus has paid the price of world, those who dwell in the earth and He is the owner as the Lord, of those who believe in Him. (1Corinthians 6:20, Psalms 24:1, Luke 2:11)
- Jesus taught the disciples as the Son of God, Rabbi (teacher), King and Lord through the authority and power of God given to Him. (Matthew 5:2, Matthew 7:29, John 13:13-14)
- We must be mastered by the Master, Lord Jesus Christ that we reflect Him in the earth. (John 14:21, Matthew 15:13, Romans 8:29-30)
- Born Again Believers are the House of Lord, built To Give God Glory under the Lordship of Jesus Our Lord. (Ephesians 2:19, 1 Corinthian 6:19)

What is the Father saying?

The Father is reminding us that Jesus is Lord and He is Our Lord! He was born, placed, positioned and empowered in the earth as He was from the beginning with God. God has exalted Him to sit in the King's seat of the Kingdom of God and has given Him all that belongs to the Creator. He is now is the owner, the Master of the Lord's House being built as the Holy Temple of God. We must remember that each of us who are born again are the many members of one body and this body is the Body of Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:12) It is this very body of many parts that is the House of God and it belongs to the Lord. The Lord Jesus Christ desires to bring glory to the Father through the splendor of His children, His house. It is through the Lordship of Christ, in His image, in His likeness that the reconciled sons of God become the like His Son, our King, our Savior, our Deliver, our Master, our Lord in the earth.
