Fundamental Truths of God:

- Jesus Christ was placed, positioned and empowered to rule and reign in heaven and earth as the King of God's kingdom.(Phil 2:9-11)
- The Kingdom of God is God's rule, His standard and His manifested life in the ones whom have entered through the Life of His King, Jesus.(John 14:6,28, Matthew 5:19-20, Romans 5:1)
- King Jesus has the agenda of God to rule in the earth as it is in Heaven, according to the will, way and Word of God. (John 13:3, Matthew 6:10, John 14:10)
- Jesus taught the disciples as the Son of God, Rabbi (teacher), King and Lord through the authority and power of God given to Him.(Matthew 5:2, Matthew 7:29, John 13:13-14)
- King Jesus remains as King and will return to gather those who have believed, adhered to and live a holy, godly life unto God our Father. (Colossians 3:1, Hebrews 12:2, Mark 16:19, Romans 8:34, Revelation 17:14,)
- The Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy and it not mere talking but of the power of God! All that the Kingdom is, it is given and rest in the life of King Jesus.(Romans 14:7, Matthew 28:18)

What is the Father saying?
